Approval of November 23, 2022 Board Meeting Minutes (D. Mallabon)

There also was a small increase in administration expenses. The 2022 Financials have been sent out for audit.

Tom will contact the stucco fence contractor to find out the status of the tile replacements. The community facing wooden fences will be evaluated in 2023, and will probably be discussed at the AGM in April.

Landscaping (G. Moriarty)

The preparation and planting of the pots for the autumn/Christmas season has been completed. Around mid-November, we received an email from the City confirming that our request for a garbage can at the pathway entrance at 77th Street and Wentworth drive has been approved. Installation is scheduled for mid-January.

New Business

Colin drafted a letter to the surrounding resident and community associations to determine if they have similar issues to ourselves in getting City engagement, and invite them to join together to provide a united voice to the City. The West Springs Community Association will also be contacted. Brenda will review which Ward 6 communities to contact. The meeting is scheduled for February 2 at 7:30 pm at the Co-op community meeting room.

The Board will also start thinking about the 2023 AGM and items to include in the meeting. This year's meeting will be in-person, and will take place in late April.

Dave will check on Amica's theatre room availability, and Brenda will check on St. Michaels Church for any room availability.
